- Seeking Passive House Certification




How we did it




- R-30 walls, R-50 roof

- Ground-source heat pumps (15 tons)
- 18 Energy Recovery Ventilators
- Air-tight building envelope
 - preliminary blower door test <.2 ACH50

Building Envelope


Air Tightness (ACH₅₀)






Window performance

Modular Construction











Fiscal and Energy Performance
